FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 7

Minutes for the special Meeting of August 20, 2024

- 1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER. The meeting was called to order at 11:30 AM by Commissioner Lopez at the District Fire Station, 1834 W. Sycamore, Fresno, TX. The Commissioners in attendance were Freddy Lopez, Sr., Barbara Hamilton, Janet McClain, and Ruston Hughes. Additional person present were: Office Manager Esmeralda Mendez; Assistant Fire Chief Tom Henderson; District Legal Counsel John Peeler of Coveler & Peeler, P.C.; Melissa Wiggins of Coveler & Peeler, P.C.; Justin Wagoner of Touchstone District Services; District Bookkeeper Mark Miller of Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.P. (via phone); and Maryann Guirguis and Ricardo Martinez of Martinez Architects.
- 2. TO RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENT AND CONDUCT THE PUBLIC HEARING/OPEN FORUM TO ALLOW INTERESTED PARTIES TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND BE HEARD REGARDING THE PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE SETTING. The Board opened the floor to public comment, though none was forthcoming.
- CONCLUDE PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE. There being no public comment, the Board unanimously agreed to conclude the Public Hearing on the District's tax increase.
- 4. TO ADOPT THE DISTRICT 2025 BUDGET. At this time, the Board was advised that no changes were made to the proposed budget for 2025. After review, a Motion was made by Commissioner McClain, and seconded by Commissioner Hamilton to adopt the District's 2025 budget as presented. The Motion was approved by a vote of 4 to 0.
- 5. TO ADOPT THE DISTRICT 2024 AD VALOREM TAX RATE FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS. The Board next reviewed information related to the District's potential 2024 tax rate, including the material published in the Notice of Public hearing. After review, a Motion was made by Commissioner Hughes, and seconded by Commissioner Hamilton, to adopt the District's M&O rate of \$0.085145/\$100. The Motion was approved by a vote of 4 to 0.
- 6. TO ADOPT THE DISTRICT 2024 AD VALOREM TAX RATE FOR DEBT SERVICE. The Board next reviewed figures to adopt the District's tax rate for debt service for 2024. After review, a Motion was made by Commissioner Hughes, and seconded by Commissioner McClain, to adopt the District's 2024 tax rate for debt service at a rate of \$0.014855/\$100. The Motion was approved by a vote of 4 to 0.
- 7. TO ADOPT THE DISTRICT 2024 TOTAL AD VALOREM TAX RATE. The Board then discussed the District's overall 2024 ad valorem tax rate. After review, a Motion was made by Commissioner Hughes, seconded by Commissioner Hamilton, to increase the ad valorem tax rate by the adoption of a rate of \$0.100000/\$100 valuation, which is

effectively an 8.95 percent increase in the tax rate. The Motion was approved by a vote of 4 to 0.

8. ADJOURNMENT. There being no further business brought before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 11:35 AM.
